

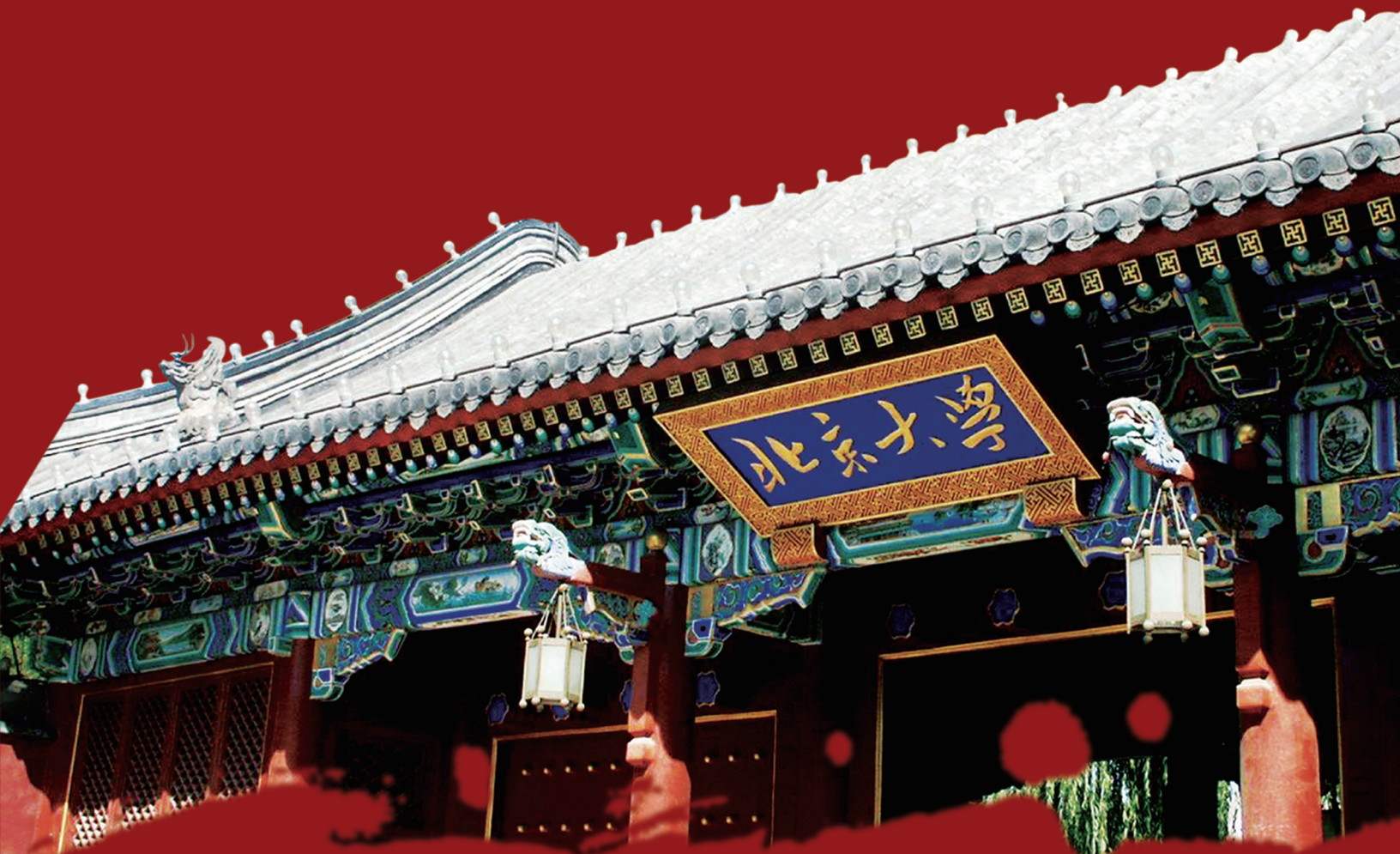

ZHOU Qifeng, Ph.D.

A native of Hunan Province, Professor Zhou Qifeng obtained his B.S. in Polymer Chemistry in 1970 from Peking University and started to work as a faculty member of Peking University in the same year. From 1978 to 1980, he studied at the Department of Chemistry of Peking University as a Master candidate. He then went to study in Department of Polymer Science & Engineering of University of Massachusetts Amherst in Massachusetts of the United States, where he received a Master degree of Science in September 1981 and a Ph.D. degree in February 1983.

Upon graduating from the University of Massachusetts Amherst, Zhou Qifeng returned to Peking University, teaching in the Chemistry Department. In 1986, he was promoted an Associate Professor, and in the same year won an award from the University for excellence in teaching. In 1990, Zhou Qifeng was promoted a Full Professor and served as the Chair of the Department of Polymer Science and Engineering, a position he held until November 2008. In 1995 he was appointed the Executive Vice Dean of the Graduate School of Peking University and Vice Provost of Peking University, until 2001 when he served joint appointments as the Director of the followings: the Ministry of Education's Graduate Students Affairs Office (then Director-General of the Division for Academic Degrees and Graduate Education), the Office of the Academic Degrees Committee of the State Council, the China Academic Degrees & Graduate Education Development Center, the General Affairs Office of the 985 Project (Ministries of Finance and Education), as well as the Office of the Inter-Ministerial Coordination Group of the 211 Project (between National Development and Reform Commission, Ministry of Finance and Ministry of Education).

In 2003 he was made a member of the Academic Degrees Committee of the State Council (a position he continues to hold), of which he was the Deputy Secretary-General from June 2003 to July 2004. In 2004 he also became a Standing Committee Member and Vice Chair of the Chemistry Division of the Chinese Academy of Sciences. From 2004 to 2008 Zhou Qifeng was the President of Jilin University, and in November 2008, was appointed the President of Peking University.

President Zhou has received many honors, for both teaching and research. He is an Academician of the Chinese Academy of Sciences, a recipient of the "National Outstanding Talent Returning from Overseas" from the State Education Commission and the Ministry of Personnel (1997), and holds the title of "National Middle-aged and Young Experts with Outstanding Contributions". In addition to other awards for noteworthy professorship, in 2001 he was given the 1st Prize for Teaching Excellence by both Peking University and the Beijing Municipal Government.

Zhou Qifeng's research interests include polymer synthesis, liquid crystalline and specialty polymers. He has published many internationally-received books and over 200 papers on these subjects.

Jeannie Jinsheng Yi (裔锦声), Ph.D.

Jeannie Yi is Managing Director of CG Group, Inc. She earned her Ph.D. from Washington University in St. Louis in the Department of Chinese and Comparative literature and went to work for Wall street, recruiting talents for major US firms since 1992. Clients include GS, JPM, UBS, CS, DB and Citi. Over the years, she has advised the top management of these firms in the areas of human capital management in Hong Kong, Singapore, Beijing and Shanghai, especially in sales, trading, and private wealth management. Among many of her volunteer work in China, she serves as liaison for Chinese Mayors Association; financial educator for Chinese Private Entrepreneurs Association; consultant to “students character formation” in Beijing and Nankai universities, and recently a member of Sichuan talents recommendation committee. Yi has lectured in more than 30 universities in China and the US, and has advised close to 50 Chinese CEOs in areas of global leadership, how to network on Wall Street, how to duplicate CEO spirit among employees, and written hundreds of articles promoting these Chinese leaders and companies, including Mr. Zhang Ruimin of Haier, Mr. Liu Yonghao of New Hope, Mr. Gao Dekang of China’s winter fashion-Bosden. The author of several influential books on Wall Street and Chinese corporate culture in both English and Chinese, among them The Haier Way and Wall Street Trilogy. Dr. Yi is also a special contributor to China’s Talent magazine, an equivalent of People magazine on China’s elite. She taught English at Peking University from 1984 to 1985.

Fan Yonghong (范勇宏), Ph.D.

Fan Yonghong is President and CEO of ChinaAMC. As a pioneer in domestic fund management industry, He established ChinaAMC in 1998. For the past 12 years, under his leadership, ChinaAMC has witnessed an incredible growth in AUM from less than RMB 1 billion to more than RMB 300 billion today, and the number of fund investors from dozens to millions. The fund broke records in many areas. To be precise, ChinaAMC was approved to be one of the first fund managers of National Social Security Fund and Enterprise Annuity, the first company to launch ETF fund, one of the first QDII fund managers, one of the first companies to manage separate account assets, and the sole manager for ABF China Bond Index Fund. The fund also has a large investment research team believing that research creates value, which helps the fund to secure a leading performance in the market. Among many outstanding awards, he was recognized as one of the 25 Most Influential People in Asset Management Industry in Asia Pacific region in May 2009, CEO of the Year by Asia Asset Management in March 2008 and March 2009 and the Most Respectable CEO of Fund Management Companies in China by Money Weekly in September 2009, and received China’s Outstanding Fund Industry Leader Award in 2007, 2008 and 2009 by Hexun.com and the title of People of the Year in China’s Fund Industry by Securities Times in January 2009. Mr. Fan holds an EMBA degree from Peking University and a Ph.D degree in Economics. He is a member of Beijing Municipal People’s Congress.



Chi-fu Huang (黄奇辅), Ph.D.

Chi-fu Huang is the Founding Partner and CEO of Platinum Grove Asset Management. He is best known for his work in modeling of swaps and derivative securities; his principal role in Long Term Catal Management; and an influential book he authored: Foundations for Financial Economics (金融经济基础一), which has become a milestone in modern finance, a text book finance department worldwide is using. Dr. Huang earned his PhD from Stanford University in 1982; he then proceeded to teach at MIT, in charge of the finance doctorate program at MIT's Sloane School of Management (1983-1993). In 1993, Huang left academia behind to join Goldman Sachs, and was initially hired to head its global fixed income derivatives research. Two years later, Huang joined LTCM where he headed the Asia trading team. Two years later, Huang moved to Tokyo to start the Tokyo office of LTCM. When LTCM closed down in 1999, Huang left to start his own hedge fund - Platinum Grove Asset Management with LTCM partner Myron Scholes, a Nobel prize winner. Huang's hedge fund employed similar fixed income arbitrage that John Meriwether pioneered at LTCM, and was a major fixed income hedge fund until 2008. Since 1995, Huang had been making trips to China, first to market G7 products to Chinese banks and corporations; later to personally invest in Chinese companies. Huang believes that China continues to be a major booming market with opportunities for everyone, but it takes patience. Even after investing in China for 15 years, he still considers himself a "beginner."

Jishu Zhou (周继述)

Jishu Zhou is Senior Managing Consultant and Chief Architect of IBM Global Financial Service Group. Trained at MIT in Aeronautics/ Astronautics and Slone School of Management, he is a specialist in combining IT and Finance in building product pricing models and in executing credit risk management system. After working for Citibank for 13 years building various models, his last position as senior member of Citibank's Advanced Basel II Committee, he returned to China to join IBM Global Financial Risk Solution Group, with an intention to assist China to set up the capital requirement system through models and risk management tools. Within a short period of one year (Zhou returned to Beijing April, 2009), he is able to distinguish himself through a series of key projects he and his team secured and accomplished for Chinese banks, this includes China's first comprehensive capital requirement system, known as Basel II, for China's #1 policy bank. This pioneering Basel II project gets special attention from China Banking Regulatory Commission and is regarded as a capital requirement "bench mark system". Prior to Citibank employment, he worked for Boston Technology for 4 years. The then cutting edge voice mail technology was later sold to the industry leader in Telecom-Verizon. Working at BT, a firm whose 50% employees had MIT background, taught him how to work under extreme pressure driven by commercial target. It proved to be one of the most valuable lessons in his career life: beat the deadline. An alumna of Shanghai Jiaotong University '77, Mr. Zhou believes with his life experience that the power of a country decides the choice of an individual. Glory belongs to the brave hearts that don't pick and choose too much. China needs us, and we need China; but how to find that notch to be win-win for both parties? In addition to market demand and vision, it also takes luck, Mr. Zhou believes.

Gary Wang (王光宇), Ph.D.

Gary Wang, Physics '85, is a co-founder and Managing Partner of Jade Capital Management LLC, an investment company that focuses on consumer and financial service sectors in China as well as real assets in North America. Mr. Wang is also one of the founding members of Quanta Capital, a Bermuda based insurance and reinsurance company listed on NASDAQ, and China Risk Finance, a leading consumer finance service provider in China. He was formerly the head of Asia Credit Derivatives of Barclays Capital. Mr. Wang started his career as a quantitative analyst at Wells Fargo Bank and subsequently an options trader of Barclays Capital in New York. Mr. Wang is currently on the board of China Risk Finance, Harvest Network, Douban Inc., and HML China. Mr. Wang received a BS in Physics from Peking University and a PhD in Physics from the University of California, San Diego.

Kun Deng (邓琨), C.F.A

Kun Deng, English '84, is a Managing Director at Lazard Asset Management where he is responsible for the global, international, and emerging markets discounted assets strategies. Among the funds he manages are The World Trust Fund, a closed-end fund listed on the London Stock Exchange, Lazard Emerging World Fund, a mutual fund listed in Dublin, and Lazard World Alternative Value Fund, a hedge fund. Mr. Deng has degrees from Columbia University and Beijing University. He serves on the boards of the following companies: Martin Currie China A Ltd, Taiwan Opportunities Trust, and CSOP China Absolute Return Fund. He is also a director of the Peking University Education Foundation (USA). In addition, Financial Times ranked him as one of the top global equity managers for the years 2000-2003, and again ranked him No. 1 in the global equity category for years 2001-2004. He was also ranked in Citywire's "Top 100 European Fund Managers" for the three consecutive years of 2005, 2006, and 2007. The Lazard Emerging World Fund, for which he is responsible, was recently awarded the "Best Fund Over Five Years" in the emerging markets category in the Nordics Region by Lipper.

Shengbei Guo (郭胜北)

Shengbei Guo, Computer Science '90, is the Founder and CEO of GSB Podium Advisors, LLC, a New York based investment management business. Its primary business is quantitative trading with statistical and technical analysis and macro-economic studies. Prior to founding GSB, Mr. Guo was the Chief Investment Officer and Managing Director of Galleon Quantitative Group. From 1997 to 2006, Mr. Guo was responsible for managing a number of hedge funds at Deutsche Bank and also served as a Managing Director in Deutsche Bank's proprietary trading business. Prior to joining Deutsche Bank in 1997, Mr. Guo worked for Morgan Stanley in the Proprietary Technical Trading Department and was also responsible for creating multiple firm-wide systems in risk management, portfolio management, accounting, trading processing and real time data processing areas. Mr. Guo received his B.S. degree in Computer Science from Peking University in 1990, his M.S. degree in Computer Science from Columbia University, and his MBA degree from Wharton School at University of Pennsylvania.



Dapeng Hu (胡大鹏), Ph.D., C.F.A

Dapeng Hu, Geology '86, is a Managing Director, Head of mortgage research group, a member of BlackRock Solutions' financial modeling group, and a member of BlackRock's Fixed Income Global Research team. Dr. Hu's primary responsibilities include directing development of BlackRock's mortgage prepayment and credit models and conducting relative value research on MBS and ABS. Prior to joining BlackRock in 2003, Dr. Hu was with Wells Fargo as a Director of financial modeling from 2001 - 2003. From 2000 - 2001, he was with Citigroup as Vice President of empirical modeling. In these positions, Dr. Hu supported mortgage servicing valuations, whole loan portfolio management, and MBS trading. From 1998 - 2000, Dr. Hu was a member of the research faculty in the Real Estate Department at the Wharton School, University of Pennsylvania. Dr. Hu earned a BS degree from Peking University in 1990, an MS degree from the Chinese Academy of Science in 1993, and a Ph.D. from the University of Pennsylvania in 1998.

Chao Ku (库超), Ph.D.

Chao Ku, Math '90, is Head of Portfolio Management and Analytics at Two Sigma Investments LLC (TSI), a multi-billion dollar, process-driven investment management firm based in New York. He also serves as Chief Investment Officer, Custom Alpha Solutions, at Two Sigma Advisers LLC (TSA), a subsidiary wholly owned by TSI. On the TSI side, his responsibilities include assisting the co-chairmen to manage the firm's flagship hedge funds. He is also responsible for managing the firm's Asian trading business. On TSA side his responsibilities include building and managing the firm's asset management business. Before joining Two Sigma in 2003, Dr. Ku held senior R&D position at Oracle Corporation and KLA-Tencor from 2000 to 2003. He studied at Peking University from 1990 to 1994 as an undergraduate before earning a PhD in mathematics from Caltech in 1999.

Daniel Lou (楼新跃)

Daniel Lou, Philosophy '88, started his career at Beijing Review first as a reporter and then as a translator and editor. He later received a MS degree in Journalism from Columbia University in 1994. He started his professional career in the United States first as an intern for Institutional Investor, then a full-time community reporter for World Journal and later a business and financial reporter/translator/editor for the same publication before he was recruited by New York Life Insurance Company as a senior management associate in 2001. He has been promoted twice since and is a director of Communications Services for this *Fortune 100* company. Mr. Lou has served as president of Peking University Alumni Association of Greater New York (PKUAAGNY) since early 2008. He also co-founded Chinese Investors Association in early 2001 and served its president until late 2007.

Zhe He (何哲)

Zhe He, Chinese Literature '90, graduated from Peking University in 1990 from a class of writers. He has been mostly an entrepreneur since. He came to the United States in 1995 and started numerous businesses and is currently the CEO of Rego Cultural Enterprises. Mr. He has always been an active member of his community in New York; he is currently the Secretary of Pen Club of Peking University Alumni Association of Greater New York.

Jian-Qiang Fan (樊健强), Ph.D.

Jian-Qiang Fan, Biology '83, received his PhD degree from Kyoto University, Japan, and conducted postdoctoral research at the Johns Hopkins University. He joined Mount Sinai School of Medicine as a faculty member in 1999, and is the first to propose and develop an emerging oral treatment for genetic disorders. His lab has discovered three drugs which are now under clinical phase III or phase II trials for inherited lysosomal storage diseases. He is the Scientific Founder of Amicus Therapeutics, Inc. (Cranbury, NJ), which is now a public company. He is an entrepreneur, a businessman, and a scholar. Dr. Fan is the founder of Pfantastic Medical Research Institute, whose mission is to research and develop treatment for diseases with unmet needs.

Hongbao Ma (马宏宝), Ph.D.

Hongbao Ma, Biochemistry '94, specializes in medical biochemistry and molecular biology, and the scientific press. Dr. Ma received his BS degree from Northwestern University, China, MS degree from Hunan Agricultural College, PhD in biochemistry from Peking University, and postdoctoral training from Harvard University. He is currently managing a research laboratory in Brooklyn's hospital. Beside the academic works, he is active in many social activities, used to be president of Michigan State University Chinese Students and Scholars Association, Lansing Chinese Association, and services for Henan Chinese Association, etc.

David W. Rong (荣伟)

David Rong, Chinese '88, is the founder and president of Sky East Media, Inc. and Art Next Gallery. He was Secretary General at REC Foundation, Inc. and curator for REEL China Documentary from 2003 to 2006, and Secretary General at the United States and China Foundation from 2001 to 2003. He received his BA degree in Chinese from Zhejiang University and MA degree in Chinese from Peking University.

Hanzhong Li (李含中), Ph.D.

Hanzhong Li, Biology '90, is currently Deputy Director, Global Commercial Development at Bayer Healthcare Pharmaceuticals, based in Montville, New Jersey. Prior to Bayer, he was a Senior Biotech Analyst in equity research at the Stanford Financial Group. Dr. Li also worked at Morgan Stanley and SunTrust Robinson Humphrey as biotech analyst and Genentech as a postdoctoral scientist. He holds a PhD degree in Pharmacology from Boston University School of Medicine and an MBA degree from University of California at Los Angeles. He studied Microbiology at Peking University from 1987 to 1990.

Bo Liang (梁波), Ph.D.

Bo Liang, Biology, is currently Co-Founder and Chief Executive Officer at Adesso Biosciences Limited, focusing on Single-Walled-Carbon-Nanotubes (SWCNTs) production and nanosensor and nano diagnostic device development, with R&D operation in Wuxi, China, as one of the Wuxi 530 Program Category A project awardees. He established Jiangsu Deda Pharmaceuticals in Taizhou in 2009, focusing on topical drug development and cGMP manufacturing. He served as Executive Vice President of Pharmaceutical Development at Foresight Biotherapeutics, Inc. from 2008 to 2010, overseeing contract pharmaceutical R&D and manufacturing, and spearheading the development of the company's intellectual property portfolio. He co-founded CLS Pharmaceuticals and served as COO in 2006, responsible for CLS' pre-clinical drug development, manufacturing and operation. He managed R&D and advanced the development of lead product into phase III clinical trials, leading to out-license to Foresight. Prior to that, Dr. Liang was a Senior Scientist at Pharmacopeia, Inc. He earned his BS from Peking University, MBA from NYU and PhD in synthetic organic chemistry from University of Pennsylvania. He serves as a member of Entrepreneurship Committee at NYU Stern Alumni Council and a board member at Sino-American Pharmaceutical Professionals Association (SAPA). He was founding president of SAPA-Greater Philadelphia chapter and also Peking University Philadelphia Alumni. He held over twenty issued or pending US and international patents, has numerous publications, and is also an Adjunct Associate Scientist at Columbia University.

Howard Liang (梁恒), Ph.D.

Howard Liang, Chemistry '84, is Managing Director and senior biotechnology analyst at Leerink Swann, a healthcare investment bank. He joined Leerink Swann in 2005 from A.G. Edwards where he was a senior biotechnology analyst. His prior Wall Street experience includes JMP Securities as a senior biotechnology analyst and Prudential Securities as an associate analyst covering major and specialty pharmaceuticals. Before that, he spent eight years at Abbott Laboratories where he was a senior scientist and a member of one of the industry's leading structure-based drug discovery teams. He was named "Best of the Street" in biotechnology by Wall Street Journal in 2009. During his career as a scientist, Dr. Liang authored papers in prestigious journals including Nature, Science, and Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences.
